VOTING IN 2020

Do you already get a **PERMANENT ABSENTEE BALLOT** in the mail for every election?

YES: <u>You are ready to vote</u>. *Congratulations!*

NO: You can get a **PERMANENT ABSENTEE BALLOT** if you are:

Confined to your home because of age or disability

or

Have difficulty getting to the <u>polls</u> or to the <u>Division of Motor Vehicles</u> (DMV) for an ID

You can use the letter on the back of this flyer to ask for a **PERMANENT ABSENTEE BALLOT**.

Send the letter to your municipal clerk.

No photo ID is needed.

If you prefer to vote at the polls on Election Day, you must show an acceptable photo ID such as:

*Wisconsin driver license (expiring <u>after</u> 11/6/18)

*Wisconsin Photo ID issued by the Wisconsin DMV (expiring after 11/6/18)

*U.S. passport (expiring <u>after</u> 11/6/18)

You must be registered to vote at your residence address.
