go.wisc.edu/StepsToVoteUW – An interactive tool. This presents customized information based upon the student's specific circumstances.

<u>MyVote.wi.gov</u> - Online registration for those with WI DL. Online registration ends 20 days before an election, at 11:59 pm on a Wednesday. Find your polling place, check your registration, see a sample ballot, request and track an absentee ballot.

<u>vote.wisc.edu</u> – UW-Madison web site with comprehensive information on voting.

<u>VoterID.wisc.edu</u> – Quick access to a student voter ID. See the 2-minute explanatory <u>movie</u>.

go.wisc.edu/VoteEvents – Events such as registration drives, early voting, election day.

go.wisc.edu/address – Students can use this link to update their address in their Student Center, then use it as proof of residence.

go.wisc.edu/verify – Proof of enrollment letter that is needed if using an expired student voter ID to get a ballot. It could also be used as proof of residence, if the address is the current voting address. (The address comes from the mailing address in Student Center's Profile section, which can be updated by the student.)

<u>rockthevote.org/online</u> – Direct links to online voter registration for 41 states. In some states, registration closes 30 days before an election.

<u>tinyURL.com/DMVLookup</u> – If you don't know your driver license number, look it up here. If you have been issued a Wisconsin driver license, that number **must** go on the voter registration form.

<u>tinyURL.com/DMVAddress</u> – Go here to change your address in the DMV database. If you want to complete your voter registration online, you need to match your name, date of birth, driver license number, and zip code with what is on file with the DMV.
